



1. Host a mom's group for new moms and moms-to-be at your church.
2. Plan a *Night of Prayer* for your church or a *Prayer Walk* for the neighborhood.
3. Encourage members to join Cradle Cincinnati's [Letters of Love](#) campaign.
4. Spread the word to members on helpful resources. Ex., *Call 211*; *text4baby*; *1.800.Quit.Now*. Request free supporting materials from Cradle Cincinnati.
5. Refer members to the faith section on Cradle Cincinnati website – reports, fliers and presentation slides are all available.
6. Use social media to spread the word about saving babies. Add cradlecincinnati.org and our [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#) and [Instagram](#) pages to your church website.
7. Ask families to spread safe sleep awareness by sharing photos of their baby sleeping safely on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.
8. Hold a Safe Sleep awareness campaign – display flyers/onesies/cribs in church lobby.
9. Participate in *Great American Smokeout* in November with emphasis on pregnant women.
10. Coordinate a *Personalized Scriptures* campaign for pregnant women – “*I know the plans I have for _____, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper her and not to harm her. Plans to give her hope and a future*” *Jeremiah 29:11*.
11. Host a *Community Cares Feast* potluck at your church and invite the community to discuss pregnancy health issues of at-risk populations. Agree on one action-step.
12. Organize a free *Moms and Babies Forum* series at your church to include doctors, nutritionists and other health specialists not readily available to at-risk moms.
13. Plan a ‘*Moms & Babies Give-Away Sunday*’ with newborn-first year baby items donated from members/community available in your church lobby to families.
14. Hold a *Mom's Morning Out* at your church with free babysitting provided by chaperoned youth group. Treat Mom to coffee/breakfast with a free coupon.
15. Host *Makeover Day for Moms* to include free hair styling, make-up, manicure, pedicure for first-time moms provided by church members in these professions.
16. Conduct mass door-to-door *Garden Give-away* – giving away fresh fruits/veggies to households with pregnant women in your neighborhood; combine with safe pregnancy education materials.

17. Go to neighborhood prenatal health centers and serve free healthy juice/drinks and snacks to those waiting. Serve the staff, too.
18. Connect families to the [Angel Baby Network](#) and share [grief resources](#) with families in your neighborhood who have experienced an infant death.
19. Give a *New Mom Basket* to ladies in your church after they announce their pregnancy. Fill with pampering items for mom and safe pregnancy resources. Repeat with *New Baby Basket* after birth with appropriate baby items.
20. *Handy Man for Mom* – host a Saturday event where men in church offer free handy-man services to single pregnant women.
21. Organize a *Card Shower* – creating a schedule of members to shower moms with cards of encouragement throughout pregnancy and their first year.
22. Hold a *Books for Babies* campaign, collecting gently-used books from members and businesses that can be distributed to new families and encourage them to read to their babies.
